Some Students are elected to these positions, which means students vote on who they want to represent them.

There are two kinds of elections.

1. Elections for our sabbatical Student Presidents. This election normally happens once every two years. These students work for the student association full time for a period of two years, to make a real difference.
2. Elections for Executive Officers. There are three of these positions available every year, so any west Lothian college student can apply. These officers look after a strategic objective and help manage our team of student volunteers called Ambassadors.

These five elected members are the decision makers of the Student Association. They are all elected by YOU and represent you. Please make sure you have your vote as these students represents you. **vote here.**
