

Travel & Study Expenses

Travel funding will only be available for students aged **22 or over** if they live out with 2 miles of the College. A One Ticket code will be provided for you to purchase a 4 weekly ticket from them, after this time the bus pass will be renewed. One Ticket passes can be used on various buses including Lothian Country. More information can be found on their website [One-ticket, participating operators](#)

If you are eligible for travel but you live out with West Lothian/Edinburgh then travel expenses will automatically be added onto your bursary award.

All students under the age of 22 must apply for an NEC travel card, this will allow unlimited travel on all buses until you reach the age of 22. Applications can be made here [Homepage - YPTS \(freebus.scot\)](#)

A Study Expense is an amount awarded to a student but paid directly to the relevant department to cover the cost of required study materials (e.g beauty kits, safety uniforms). For students under the age of 18 this is not means-tested but for students over the age of 18 it is means tested.
